Subject: Amendment of Agreement No. USOF/SP/354 Uncovered/2018-19 dated 28-04-2020 for subsidy support from USO Fund to provide Mobile Services in 354 Uncovered Villages as part of uncovered villages Project under the Indian Telegraph (2nd Amendment of 2013) Rules, 2013

1. WHEREAS the Government of India has approved to provide additional 55 mobile towers in 354 Uncovered Villages Project for Provision of Mobile Services with subsidy support of Rs 54,13,32,750 from USOF under the captioned Agreement and communicated to M/s RJIO vide letter no. USOF/354 village Scheme/2020-21/Execution/Survey dated 06.09.2021.


2. In pursuance of the Clause(s) 3.6 of Section-III (General Condition) -Extension of Agreement and 3.7 of Section-III (General Condition)- Modification in Terms and Condition in Agreement, the terms and condition of the captioned agreement are hereby amended, with the approval of the Administrator, with immediate effect to the extant as detailed below:

6	4.3.1 Section-IV (Commercial Conditions)	The Administrator or his representative or the agencies authorized (Hereinafter Designated Monitoring Agency) shall have the right to inspect and test the created infrastructure and provision of mobile services as per prescribed test schedules for their conformity to the specifications. Where the Administrator decides to conduct such tests on the infrastructure sites created by USPs, all reasonable facilities and assistance like testing instruments and other test gadgets including access to drawings and other details shall be furnished to the Designated Monitoring Agency at no charge to the Administrator.	In addition to provisions contained in clause 4.3.1, After installation and commissioning of BTS/sites, coverage testing will be done by respective LSA of DoT, which will submit its report, circle-wise, as & when carried out to USOF and / or its Designated Monitoring Agency (DMA) for deciding further action to be taken, in terms of Subsidy deductions or financial penalties.

3. All other terms and conditions of the said agreement shall remain unchanged and the relevant provisions of the agreement & of the instructions/guidelines/directions issued/to be issued thereunder would also be applicable for these 55 additional villages.
