1. The request of M/s BHL for reduction of PBG from existing 5% to 3% in respect of the 502 Aspirational District scheme has been considered and the approval of competent authority is hereby conveyed for amendment of clause no. 7.3.1 of the Agreement No. USOF/Aspirational Districts/1/Rajasthan/2020 dated 22/03/2021 as below:


